

## **Quick Guide - How to apply for LAW423**

LAW423 is a simulated placement course, where students are guided by a practising solicitor in a simulated work environment for 3 hours a week. During this time you will have the opportunity to observe and participate in the provision of legal assistance to real clients. In conjunction with a practising solicitor you will be involved in client interviews, conducting legal research, preparing legal advice and drafting correspondence. This course will develop your practical skills and your understanding of the daily life of a legal practitioner.

Because of the Work Integrated Learning nature of LAW423, this course operates slightly differently to other LAW coursework you may be used to. There are several mandatory requirements students need to meet before they can undertake their legal assistance tasks.
